

## **Church-based community Organiser**

*Context: St Andrew's Stamford Hill*

The Centre for Theology and Community is recruiting a part-time community organiser to help this East London parish harness the potential of organising, rooted in prayer and theological reflection, to fulfil its mission.

The one day per week (0.2 FTE) role will initially run for twelve months, with a one month probationary period.

The key tasks will be

### *Worshipping God*

- to have one-to-ones to develop a team to launch a monthly informal family service at St Andrew's on Sunday afternoons within three months of appointment
- to work with the priest-in-charge and church council to reinstate a monthly all-age Eucharist in the spring or summer of 2022

### *Building Community to Challenge injustice*

- to continue to sustain St Andrew's engagement with Hackney & Islington Citizens, developing work with people of all faiths and none
